Explore the Rich History of Alexandria: A Full-Day Guided Tour from Cairo

Your guide will meet you at your Cairo hotel early in the morning to begin your Alexandria day tour from Cairo. Enjoy a comfortable three-hour drive along the desert highway in an air-conditioned vehicle, heading to one of Egypt's most historically rich cities—Alexandria.

Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa

Begin your tour with a visit to the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, a subterranean burial site from the 2nd century A.D. These multi-story tombs are a mixture of Pharaonic, Greek, and Roman styles that represent the unique culture in which Alexandria exists. Definitely the highlight of any Egypt day tour.

Pompey's Pillar

Next, visit Pompey's Pillar, a towering Roman column made from Aswan granite. Built in honor of Emperor Diocletian in 297 AD, this monument stands nearly 27 meters tall and is the largest of its kind outside Rome. Your guide will explain the real story behind its name and history.

Roman Amphitheater

Continue to the Roman Amphitheater in Kom El-Dikka, the only one of its kind in Egypt. It once had marble seating arranged in 13 rows for public events and lectures. This site is a must-see, evoking the history of Roman Alexandria.

Citadel of Qaitbay

Your next destination is the Citadel of Qaitbay. Built in the 15th century, the citadel is situated where the ancient Lighthouse of Alexandria used to stand. Enjoy wonderful vistas of the Mediterranean and explore one of the city's most iconic landmarks.

Lunch by the Sea

Relax over a fresh seafood lunch at a local restaurant by the coast, where you can enjoy authentic Mediterranean dishes in a scenic setting.

Library of Alexandria

End your tour at the modern Library of Alexandria (Bibliotheca Alexandrina). Opened in 2002, it celebrates the legacy of the ancient library and promotes learning and cultural exchange across generations.
