Day 1

Explore the Beauty of Giza

Then, transfer in an air-conditioned vehicle with your tour guide to enjoy a great excursion to the Pyramids of Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus, some of the most impressive [Giza attractions](#). Finish your tour there and then proceed to visit the Great Sphinx, which dates back to the time of Chephren, and explore the Valley Temple.

Afterward, go to the Step Pyramid of Zoser (King Djoser's) which is the world's oldest giant stone structure in ancient Egypt built during the 3rd Dynasty. On [Egypt Day tours](#) you will then proceed to lunch at a local restaurant. Subsequently driven to Memphis, Kingdoms of Egypt, the city founded by King Menes and for a heart and soul of rule & culture for more than 3000 years. Next, you will see the Statue of Ramses II and the Saqqara alabaster Sphinx of Memphis. Go also for Djoser's first step pyramid in Djourah along with other amazing pyramids.
