Day 1

Arrival in Cairo

Then it's Aswan Nile cruise itinerary time, sailing forward to Edfu and then having dinner served on board while ending the day.

Day Trip with Luxor Attractions

Enjoy your breakfast and then start your fifth day in Egypt by visiting the most well-preserved temple, the Temple of Horus.
