Day 1

Start off the Adventure

When you land at Cairo International Airport, you will be assisted in completing the arrival processes by a representative from Best Destinations Tours. Day 2

Cairo Full Day Tour

After having your breakfast, you will be met at the hotel by your English-speaking tour guide who will accompany you to the [Giza Pyramids](#). One of the Seven Wonders of the World, you will get to see The Great Pyramid of King Cheops, with in addition, the Middle Pyramid of his Son, Chephren. Moreover, we will visit also the Pyramid of King Mycerinus, The Valley Temple of King Chephren, and The Great Sphinx, which is a huge statue located at the Giza Plateau, on the outskirts of Cairo.

Then you will proceed to a designated area where you will visit the famous [Egyptian Museum](#) , which is housed in a two-storied building with the largest collection of Egypt collection in the world among others the precious golden artifacts of the boy King Tutankhamun related to the Valley of the Kings.

Now we will start touring [Coptic Cairo](#) where the first location will be the old Roman structure of Babylon, fort walls, and the Hanging Church that is above the two sever towers of the old Babylon fort. You will also get to see the Church of Abu Serga and the Ben Ezra Synagogue which is an ancient synagogue built in the old part of Cairo.

Savor your meal at a well-known Egyptian eatery and resume our activities afterward. And then, we will also proceed to Islamic Cairo after this, and you will view some of the significant mosques built in the Islamic era as well as [Khan El Khalili](#), the ancient market of Cairo, prior to heading back to the hotel.

Day 3

East Bank of Luxor

Make all arrangements for your departure from the hotel in Giza from where you will be taken to Cairo International Airport for a short flight to Luxor, the city associated with tourism in Egypt best. West Bank of Luxor

Have your lunch while cruising to the Edfu located on the west bank of the Nile in the southern part of Egypt.

Afterward, experience an open bouquet full of fresh food followed by music and belly dancing.

In between this, it has also been tried to give an option of hot balloon rides to the tourists who visit Luxor so that they can have an aerial shot of the beautiful landscapes along the river Nile

and the ancient temples.
