Itinerary

Day 1

Arrive to Cairo

Upon your arrival at the Cairo international airport, you will be welcomed by a representative from [Best Destination Tours](#) who will assist you in clearing the baggage checkpoint and intimation control at the airport. After this, he will take you in a modern, fully air-conditioned private vehicle to a five-star hotel in Cairo. In the evening, you may choose to enjoy a

wonderful dinner cruise on the Nile river in Cai
Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2

Tour to Cairo

Following a delectable breakfast at the hotel, you will meet up with your certified tour guide for your tours in Cairo to explore the Giza Pyramids. The Great Pyramid of King Cheops is a fourth-dynasty pyramid. Also, visit the pyramids of King Khufu's successors, Khafre and Menkaure, during the festival of the old kingdom of Egypt. After that, take a picture of the pyramids, visiting the Great Sphinx, which is a fascinating statue of a man's head on the body of a lion positioned adjacent to the Pyramids of Giza. Then we head to the historical Tahrir square, transferring 'shuttle,' the most known and one among the largest squares in Egypt and found in Cairo. At this point, there will also be the opportunity to visit the Egyptian Museum, with over 120,000 exhibits containing many enormous statues, gold-locked coffins, burial boxes, and preserved bodies. After lunch, the next place will be Egypt's oldest market, Khan El Khalili Bazar, where you will have a local cafe trying tea-mint and visit the region mainly for Islamic Cairo tours and activities. At the end of the Cairo day tours, you will be taken back to the hotel. Stay the night.

Food: Breakfast Lunch

Day 3

Alexandria tour from Cairo

After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, embark on your private, air-conditioned vehicle to begin your day trip to Alexandria from Cairo. When you get there, your day tour in Alexandria will commence by going to the Roman Katakombos Kom El Shoqafa. Proceed to the location of the ruins of the Alexandria Serapeum built by Ptolomy III.

Then, head to the 15th-century Citadel of Qaitbay, where Muslim Mamluk Sultan Qaitbay had built a fort to defend the city from invading crusaders. On the way, we will pass by the Bibliotheca Alexandrina, as it is the present-day Bibliotheca that promotes science and scientific research in various spheres. There will be a seafood meal in a restaurant that overlooks the port, and after checking in at the Alexandria hotel, you will return to the hotel. overnight in Alexandria.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4

Alexandria to El Alamein

Savor your breakfast in the hotel Alexandria, then check-out and transfer to El Alamein for a visit to the El Alamein War Cemetery. Your expert tour guide will provide you with all the information during the visit. After that, transfer to Marsa Matrouh, the wonderful city located on the shores of the Mediterranean, in order to have lunch, then drive further in the direction of the Siwa oasis. When you get there, you will go to the hotel to drop your bags and then relocate to one of the hot springs to take a dip into the warm water and ease the aches in your muscles caused by a long day's journey. Siwa overnight.

Day 5

Siwa Attraction

You will proceed to commence the excursion into the Siwa Oasis Desert at the Shali Fortress, which has a portion of Sycamore Partie melted down. thereafter move the Seen Temple of the Oracle located in Aghurmi of the 26th dynasty. Proceed in visiting the temple of Amun Ra situated at Um Ubeyda, which was dedicated to the trinity temple of god Amun. then appreciate the distinct Siwan culture, such as in the case of the Siwa House Museum's

exhibits of the Siwa Bedouin tribe's materials and collections. Have lunch at the famous Oasis Square that has a fantastic view of the fortress where Abdo Restaurant is located. In the afternoon, visit Cleopatra's Spring, where you can swim in the refreshing waters, and then get ready to take a boat to Fitnas Island and watch the unforgettable sunset there. Dinner and overnight will be at Siwa.

Day 6

Continue Siwa Attractions

Breakfast at the Eco-lodge, then continue your Siwa Oasis desert safari to the rock-cut tombs into the Mountain of the Dead. It is a mountain where several tombs were carved on its base, terraces, and at the top. You will be back at the hotel to take another 4x4 vehicle to start your Great Sand Sea Tour. Drive to one of the fascinating sites in the Great Sand Sea, a beautiful site for its phenomena that move their sand like waves of the sea. Then, get excited by the sandboarding experience; although not as fast as snowboarding, with the right way, you can shoot down some of the massive dunes in the great sand sea and have thrills to spare. After sandboarding, it is time to wash up in the hot spring renowned as Bir Wahid for chilling and stretching our muscles thanks to the 40 degrees warm water, enjoy another breathtaking sunset at the great sand sea in the middle of the dunes while having Bedouin tea. Overnight in Siwa.

Day 7

Back to Cairo

Breakfast will be offered earlier at the eco-lodge so that you can prepare for the almost 8-hour drive back to Cairo, including rest stops. After reaching Cairo, you will be escorted to
