Day 1

Start of Your Trip

Day 4

Abu Simbel tour - Kom Ombo

Pick up from your hotel in Aswan by a modern air-conditioned coach to enjoy a small group tour to Abu Simbel. The two Temples of Abu Simbel, with their unique style, are considered to be the masterpieces of ancient Egypt. The Temple of Ramses II was dedicated to the four universal gods Ptah, Re-Her-Akhtey, Amun-Re, and to Ramses II himself. The great Abu Simbel temple is also called The Sun Temple of Ramses II. The Temple of Queen Nefertari is also called the Temple of Hathor, who was the wife of the Sun God, so symbolically, the two Temples, that of Ramesses II and that of Nefertari, bring Ramesses II, Nefertari, Hathor, and the Sun God together as one. Later on, you will be escorted back from Abu Simbel to your Cruise in Aswan for embarkation. Visit Kom Ombo, you'll sail to Kom Ombo, where you'll encounter the twin temple of Kom Ombo, where you'll learn about the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Horus, whose monuments decorate each half of the temple.

Day 5

Edfu temple - Luxor

After breakfast on board, you'll have your lunch back on board the ship and sail on to Luxor where you'll stop to visit Edfu Temple, the best-preserved temple of the ancient world. The structure is dedicated to Horus, the falcon god. During your journey, you will also experience the comfort and elegance of a luxury Nile cruise. Reboard the ship for afternoon tea and a leisurely ride to Esna. Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 6

Sail to Luxor Attractions

In the early morning, enjoy breakfast on board as you sail to Luxor. You'll then set out to visit the West Bank of Luxor, take an excursion to the Royal Cemetery for 62 Pharaohs, the Valley of the Kings, then to the mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was built by the architects of the New Kingdom during the 15th century BCE at Deir El-Bahari. You'll proceed to the towering Colossi of Memnon. disembarkation, and then you will be accompanied by your tour guide to the ancient Karnak and Luxor temples along the east bank of Luxor, then transfer to Luxor Airport for your flight back to Cairo, where we will meet you, then transfer to your hotel.
