Next, travel to Fez via a stop at the UNESCO World Heritage site of Volubilis, where your guide will highlight the Roman and Berber ruins, a highlight often included in Morocco and Egypt tours and luxury multi-country tours. Next comes a visit to Meknes, also known as the 'Versailles of Morocco.' Here, you will observe Bab El Mansour and Lhri with your local guide; finally, continue onward to Fez, continuing your immersive multi-country trips.

Note: Kaab Ghazal means "hoof of the deer" in Arabic. Mint tea, along with Kaab Ghazal and Ghariba, is the quintessence of the living embodiment of Moroccan hospitality.

Day 3

Know More about Fes

After breakfast, take a guided tour of Fez, which was the capital before 1912. Explore Fez Medina, a UNESCO World Heritage Site set up in the 9th century and believed to have hosted the world's oldest university, an enriching stop on many Morocco tours and multicountry vacations. Other major sites to visit include Bou-Inania and Attarin Medersa, the tanneries, Ess-Seffarine Square, the tomb of Moulay Driss, Nejjarine Square, the cabinet makers' souk, and the Hebrew quarter called 'Mellah,' all popular highlights on Morocco and Egypt tours as well as multi-country trips. Enjoy a hands-on pottery workshop with a local artisan to make a truly Moroccan experience. After lunch in a local restaurant, you may relax in your hotel or meander freely through the alleys of the old town, soaking in the charm of luxury multi-country tours.

Did you know? Fez hosts one of the largest Sufism festivals every October, drawing performers from across the world.

Presently, GEM Complex provides limited-entry options to check on site readiness and to improve visitor experience prior to official opening. At present, access is limited to the Main Galleries, Grand Hall, Grand Staircase, commercial area, and exterior gardens. Return to the hotel afterward, reflecting on an incredible day in your multi-country vacations and multi-country trips.

Fly from Cairo to Luxor to Start Your Nile Cruise
