Arrival at Muscat International Airport

Day 2

Oman Tour in Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque, Muttrah

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and drive through the beautiful embassy area of Muscat toward the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque. Visit this magnificent mosque, a landmark in Muscat, where the splendor of distinct Islamic architecture is apparent (please note there is a strict Islamic dress code). Finished in 2001, this mosque is considered the primary mosque of Oman and is one of only two mosques in the Sultanate that non-Muslims can visit (the other being in Salalah). It is a prominent highlight in many Oman tours and a must-see stop on cultural Middle East holidays. Gaze at the second-largest handmade carpet in the world and huge chandeliers installed in the main prayer hall, details admired by travelers on luxury Middle East tours and insightful tours to Middle East.

On the way back from the city center to the old town, you will pass by the Opera House only concert hall in the Gulf. From there, go for a visit to the 16th-century forts of Jalali and Mirani, often admired by those on extended Middle East trips. Following that, have a relaxing walk around the old town quarter and stop for a photo at Qasr Al Alam, His Majesty Sultan Qaboos's official palace, utilized mainly for official purposes.

Then, go on to Bait Al Zubair Museum, which is teeming with exhibits and information on the country's culture, traditions, and heritage. This enriching experience is often part of curated Middle East tours and a favorite for travelers enjoying Middle East vacations. Afterward, continue to Muttrah, the charming quarter of Muscat. Famous as one of the most beautiful Oriental markets in the Gulf States, Muttrah Souq is a must-see. Enter the fish market and walk along the Corniche to admire the beautiful merchant houses while shopping at the busy souk, a perfect ending for many trips to Middle East, as well as a unique contrast to urban Dubai tours. Finally, return to your hotel.

Day 3

Explore Nakhl Fortress, Hajar Mountain

From 08:00, depart from the hotel with your guide in a 4x4 for the trip to Nakhl fortress and Al Thowara oasis. You will explore the date palm groves and natural springs of the oasis and visit Nakhl, a hilltop 17th-century fortress that commands wonderful views of the surroundings. This type of experience is commonly featured in Oman tours and is a favorite among those on immersive [Middle East holidays](#).

Then, continuing on a mountain track into the Hajar Mountain Range toward Wadi Bani Auf, there are spectacular views and good campsites once the dirt track runs west along the ridge. Such natural beauty and cultural heritage are often part of high-end luxury Middle East tours and traditional tours to Middle East. You can also visit a centuries-old mountain village there, a highlight for those seeking authentic Middle East trips. Return to Muscat late in the afternoon. In all, around 8 hours will be spent on this tour, one of many enriching Middle East tours that attract travelers planning Middle East vacations or considering future trips to Middle East beyond the more urban-focused Dubai tours.

Day 4

See the Beauty of Nizwa and Jabal Akhdar

At 08:00, your guide will assist you in driving a distance of 145 kilometers to the UNESCO-famous spot, the medieval capital of Oman, Nizwa. In Nizwa, you will tour a 17th-century hilltop fortress overlooking the town and its souq. This destination is one of the cultural highlights often featured in Oman tours and broader Middle East holidays. After your visit, you will be taking on Jabal Akhdar ('Green Mountain') in your 4x4. While driving through its off-

road tracks, you will ascend to nearly 3000 meters above the level. The edges of the valley are lined with small villages and terraced fields, creating an indescribably beautiful backdrop often captured on Middle East vacations.

You are going to enter the summit of the mountain, which holds a magnificent panoramic view of the entire region. Next, there is even a hotel that serves some light refreshments, with an option for tea or coffee, a relaxing moment typical of luxury Middle East tours. From the peak, you will drive back to Muscat, where you will reach your hotel approximately at 16:00 hours. The tour lasts for 8 hours and is one of the many enriching tours to Middle East enjoyed by travelers on Middle East trips, from cultural getaways to immersive Middle East tours, offering alternatives to popular Dubai tours and other sought-after trips to Middle East.

Thereafter, one heads over to the Zaabeel Area, passing Sheikh Mohamed Bin Rashid's Palace, the ruler of Dubai at present, and Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid's Palace. This excursion is one of many offered in Middle East tours, giving a glimpse into both history and modernity. Next stop is Jumeirah Mosque, and then photo stops for [Burj Al-Arab](#), the most lavish hotel in the world, sitting tall on a manmade island. This landmark is always a highlight in Dubai tours and is sometimes spotlighted during luxury Middle East tours. After that, visit the Palm Jumeirah, an artificial island in the shape of a palm tree, and then onwards to [Atlantis the Palm](#).

Continue to keep the flame alive as the journey continues towards [Dubai Mall](#), where under an hour will be spent in the exploration of Dubai Aquarium and Underwater Zoo, observing the aquatic creatures. We then move toward [Burj Khalifa](#). From here, a 50-second elevator ride to the summit of this historic monument, listed as one of the world's tallest buildings, awaits you. These iconic experiences are a hallmark of Middle East holidays and attract those seeking memorable Middle East trips. Eventually, be dropped back to your hotel in Dubai, after a day that showcases what goes into tours to Middle East and provides insight into what makes trips to Middle East appealing.
