Take a walk in the Grand Socco alleys to behold the imposing fortress of Kasbah overlooking the medina. Then, not far from there lies the Sultan's Palace, which turned into a museum showcasing the arts of Morocco.

Day 2

Rabat, Morocco's administrative capital, is a city full of history and culture. After breakfast, depart for Rabat to see Mechouar Square, the Royal Palace (exterior), the Mausoleum of Mohamed V, Hassan Tower, and the Kasbah of Oudayas. Along the way, you'll discover things to do in [Rabat](#), like exploring the Kasbah of Oudayas, a majestic fortress surrounded by lush gardens, and visiting the ancient ruins of La Chellah, a Merinid necropolis.

Casablanca - The City of the Future

Casablanca is a vibrant metropolis, blending modernity with tradition. Known for its stunning architecture and economic prowess, it's the heartbeat of Morocco's industry and commerce. After breakfast, continue on the cultural side of [Casablanca](#) such as Hassan II Mosque (together with its majestic minarets by far the highest in the world), the Anfa area, and the charming Medina of Al Habous.
