In Wadi Rum, you will participate in a jeep safari tour led by a local Bedouin and experience the magic of the "valley of the moon," one of the most spectacular desert landscapes on earth. At the end of the tour, you will overnight and relax at the Dead Sea.

Day 1 Arrival Amman

Upon arrival, a member of our staff will meet you at Queen Alia International Airport. Transfer to hotel in Amman. Overnight at hotel.

Day 2

Wadi Rum/ Petra

After breakfast, head south to Wadi Rum, Jordan's largest natural desert area and its most majestic as jagged rock stackings turn into vast expanses of golden dunes. While traversing, stop at the best Jordan attractions (Wides open desert scenes & ancient places) on the road. Take an exhilarating jeep tour in the desert with local Bedouins, who will show you narrow canyons, ancient petroglyphs, and high cliffs of the desert. After your adventure, start heading to Petra, a must-see on any international trip, and arrive at your hotel for an overnight stay to wake up and discover the magic of this ancient rose-red city the next day.

Day 3

Petra Exploration/ Dead Sea

After breakfast, we will start our journey to explore Petra, aptly described as the "rose-red city, half as old as time." The ancient city was founded by the Nabateans 2000 years ago. Its massive architectural structure and its multicolored stones are an incredible attraction. As you explore, you'll discover some of the top 10 places to visit in Jordan, with Petra being one of the most iconic. The visit to the ancient Nabatean capital starts on horseback, followed by a walk through the Siq, a long narrow fissure between two overhanging cliffs. Towards the end of the Siq, you will be spellbound by Petra's most famous monument, the Treasury. As you continue your journey, you'll uncover unique things to do in Jordan as the tour gradually

reveals the mysteries of the city. Afterward, transfer to the Dead Sea for an overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 4

Visit Dead Sea and Be Ready for Final Departure

After you have your breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for departure, leaving behind the beautiful places in Jordan that have made your trip unforgettable.

Tour inside the desert of Wadi Rum in a 4x4 vehicle for 3 hours.

Private tour of Petra with a local guide (tour length is 2 hours, and covers the lower parts of Petra).
