Day 3

Day 5

Seville Exploration

Have breakfast before breaking into the beauty of the city through a guided tour that includes visits to most of the major treasures of the city, amongst which arises the magnificent [Seville](#) Cathedral, which is the second-largest cathedral in the world, and the historic Santa Cruz quarter, which owes its origins to the inspiration for the tales of Carmen and Don Juan. The afternoon is free to explore Seville's three elements, from tapas to shopping and even watching people in one of the lovely squares.
