Day 2

Kasr Ibrim, Amada & Nubian Culture on Lake Nasser Cruise

After breakfast on board your elegant Lake Nasser cruise, the day of Lake Nasser cruise 4 day begins with a scenic early sailing to the legendary Kasr Ibrim. While landing is no longer permitted, the view from the sundeck offers a breathtaking glimpse of this ancient citadel

perched above the Nile—now an island due to the creation of the Aswan High Dam. Once a powerful city, Kasr Ibrim remains a symbol of Nubia resilient history.

Following the onboard lunch, your Egypt Nile Cruise will continue with a guided visit to the Temple of Amada, said to be the oldest among the Nubian temples. The temple is believed to have been created by the great Pharaoh Thutmose III of the 18th dynasty and further developed by Amenhotep II and Thutmose IV; this sacred edifice is graced by magnificent wall reliefs and well-preserved inscriptions depicting some royal history.

Thereafter, proceed to the Temple of Derr, a temple set up by Ramses II, carved into the rocks on the eastern bank of the Nile, an uncommon architectural style in the region. This hidden treasure manifests the king typical design in rock-cut architecture, with vibrant scenes depicting ancient ceremonies and military conquests.

Now on to the fantastical Tomb of Pennut, one of the fewer rock-cut tombs within the region that were relocated to save them from being submerged due to the construction of the Aswan High Dam. As belonging to the Viceroy of Kush, this site offers a rare insight into the lives of elite officials in ancient Nubia.

In the evening, as your cruise sails gently toward Wadi El Seboua, prepare for a lively Nubian show in Egypt and a charming cocktail reception on board. Let the rhythm of traditional Nubian music and dance immerse you in the vibrant culture of southern Egypt. Dinner will be served onboard, followed by a peaceful overnight stay under the stars.

#### Explore Wadi El Seboua Temples On Lake Nasser Cruise– Sail to Aswan

Enjoy breakfast on board your Lake Nasser cruise before heading out for a memorable day at Wadi El Seboua Temple, one of the highlights of any Egypt Nile cruise. This impressive site along the shores of Lake Nasser is home to several ancient Nubian temples that were relocated to save them from rising waters. ### Day 2

Explore Kalabsha Temple-A Lake Nasser Cruise Adventure

Wake up to a scenic morning on your Lake Nasser Nile Cruise, where breakfast will be served onboard the luxurious MS Nubian Sea Lake Nasser Cruise. Today, your Egyptologist tour guide will accompany you on a fascinating journey to discover the ancient Kalabsha Temple, one of the most remarkable Nubian monuments. Overlooking the High Dam, the temple lives up to its name as the quintessential opening act of a Lake Nasser cruise. Originally 30 miles to the south, it was relocated to save it from the rising water levels post-dam construction. An interesting blend of Egyptian and Roman architecture could be perhaps the best way to describe the temple, displaying figures from the Roman emperors to the Egyptian gods. Dedicated to the Nubian sun god Mandulis, Kalabsha is a stunning example

of cultural fusion in ancient Egypt.

Your Egypt tour continues with a visit to Beit El Wali, another temple that was saved from submersion and relocated by a Polish archaeological team with support from the Oriental Institute of Chicago and the Swiss Institute of Cairo. This rock-cut type of temple known as a speos consists of a big hall and a transverse antechamber supported by columns before the sacred sanctuary. Detailed reliefs showing conquest and devotion adorn the walls of the temple, giving us greater insight into the Nubian-Egyptian culture.

Afterward, return to the cruise for an invigorating rest and lunch. Setting sail again towards Wadi El Sebou while crossing the Tropic of Cancer, the ship will present this segment on the Nile, undoubtedly one of the most serene ones, with your cherished views.

Day 3

Explore Wadi El Sebou & Dakka Temples on Lake Nasser Cruise

Start your day with the lovely breakfast served aboard for the Lake Nasser cruise before embarking on yet another unforgettable chapter in the Egypt tour. After the breakfast, disembark for a visit to the great sites of Wadi El Sebou-from the Arabic term-"Valley of the Lions" on account of the splendid avenue of sphinxes gracing the temple entrance. This Nubian temple was erected by the great Ramesses II and was moved in the 1960s to enterprise against being submerged. The place is pleasing, tranquil, and somewhat off the beaten track, which makes for one of the gems of any Wadi El Sebou tour.

After your enriching exploration of these Nubian monuments, you will return to the ship for lunch. While enjoying your meal, the boat sails towards Amada. Later in the day, you'll visit the Temple of Amada, the oldest surviving structure along Lake Nasser, dating back to the 18th Dynasty of ancient Egypt—centuries before Abu Simbel. Although older than many sites featured on a classic Egypt Nile cruise, the Amada Temple still preserves vivid colors and inscriptions. Inside, you'll also find carvings added by Ramesses II and his son Merenptah, leaving their imprint on this deeply spiritual monument.

Enjoy dinner back onboard as your Nile cruise itinerary continues toward more treasures of ancient Nubia.

### **Explore The Highlight of Your Lake Nasser Nile Cruise**

Continue your 5-day Lake Nasser Nile Cruise from Aswan to Abu Simbel with a scenic sail towards one of the most iconic monuments in all of Egypt. The Abu Simbel Temples, built by the great Pharaoh Ramesses II, are cut deep into the face of the granite cliff that rises

beyond the Nile shore in two enormous statues that guard the entrance to the temple. These two impressive temples were relocated against all odds in 1968 following the building of the Aswan High Dam by a UNESCO-led effort to protect them from submersion caused by the filling waters of Lake Nasser.

Enjoy a guided visit into the temple, enjoying the sights of ancient carvings and hieroglyphs with solar alignment that has puzzled historians and travelers for centuries. This day, being a grand pinnacle of the whole Lake Nasser cruise experience, will be a must-see stop in any Egypt tour.

Once the sun sets, guests may opt to attend the Sound & Light Show at Abu Simbel. This show is an immersive experience that sets the ancient temples alive with the sounds of music, narration, and dramatic lighting effects.
