# **Itinerary**

#### Day 1

#### **Arrival in Aswan**

At the time of your arrival, a representative from Best Destination Tours will assist you at your hotel or Aswan Airport. After boarding the cruise before lunch, your visit to the Philae Temple and leisurely Felucca sail with stunning views of the Nile will occur. For those interested in more exploration, Egypt tours can be arranged to enhance your experience. Overnight in Aswan.

#### Day 2

### Abu Simbel Temples and Sail to Kom Ombo

You will travel very early in the morning to Abu Simbel, which is 3 hours away by car, for an unforgettable visit to the temples of Ramses II and Nefertari. For a more in-depth experience, you can also opt for an Abu Simbel tour from Aswan. After returning to Aswan, the ship will sail to Kom Ombo to visit the unique double temple of the crocodile god Sobek and the god Haroeris. Lunch on board. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Nile as the ship continues on its way to Edfu. Dinner and overnight stay. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

## Day 3

## Visit Temple of Edfu

Visit the beautiful temple of Horus in Edfu by horse-drawn cart and absorb the richness of its historical significance. As you go, take time to explore the bustling local bazaars for souvenirs. If you're interested in expanding your journey, there are plenty of things to do in Aswan that you can explore during your stay. Luxor will be your overnight stop. Meals included: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner.

#### Day 4

**Luxor Sightseeing and Final Departure** 

After breakfast, you will cross the Nile River to the west bank of Luxor and go to the Valley of

the Kings, where many Pharaohs and Nobles of Egypt have had their tombs dug into the

rock, which is watchfully guarded by Colossi of Memnon. For a more comprehensive

experience, you can consider taking a 4-day Aswan to Luxor Nile cruise with an Abu Simbel

temple visit to see even more of Egypt's ancient marvels. Continue your journey through

Luxor West Bank history, visiting the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, followed by Karnak and

Luxor temples across the Nile. At last, transfer to Luxor Airport or Luxor train station, where

you will be dropped off for departure.


