# **Itinerary**

Day 1

**Arrival in Luxor** 

Upon arrival to Luxor, start your All-inclusive 5-day Nile cruise package from Hurghada by meeting your private tour guide to discover ancient Egyptians' civilization in the most famous archaeological sites along the Riverbank in Luxor East Bank like:

Karnak Temple, no site in Egypt is more impressive than the Karnak temple. The Temple of Luxor was the center of the most important festival, the festival of Opet. Built largely by Amenhotep III and Rameses II, the temple's purpose was a setting for the rituals of the festival. At the end of the day, return to the cruise and overnight on board. Meals: Lunch. Dinner

Day 2

#### Cruise to West Bank of Luxor

In this day, you shall visit the Valley of the Kings, the final resting place of Egypt's rulers from the 18th to the 20th dynasty. It is home to tombs including the great Pharaoh Ramses II and the boy king Tutankhamen. The tombs were well stocked with all the material goods a ruler might need in the next world. Most of the decoration inside the tombs is still well preserved. Hatshepsut Temple, one of the most beautiful and best-preserved of all the temples of Ancient Egypt, is a must-see during your Egypt trips. The temple was built on three levels, with two wide ramps in a central position joining the levels together. Colossi of Memnon, two massive stone statues of King Amenhotep III, are the only remains of a complete mortuary temple. The statues are made from blocks of quartzite sandstone, which exist in Cairo and were then moved 700 KM to Luxor. As you explore Luxor attractions, you will continue your journey to Esna and Edfu. Overnight in Edfu. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

#### Day 3

#### Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples Tour

After breakfast, move to explore "The Temple of God Horus": Edfu temple is considered the most preserved Greco-Roman temple all over Egypt, and on its walls, it portrays a play showing the overcoming of Horus over the devil god Seth. Then sail to Kom Ombo to visit Kom Ombo Temple: A temple overlooking the Nile. This temple is divided into 2 temples with 2 entrances, 2 hypostyle halls, and 2 sanctuaries. As part of your journey, consider adding a Nile cruise and Red Sea tours to fully experience the beauty of Egypt. Overnight in Aswan (late night arrival). Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4

Sail to Aswan with Nile Cruise

On this day, you will visit the High Dam, which was built across the Nile at Aswan. The High Dam was constructed between 1960 and 1970 and has had a significant effect on the economy and culture of Egypt. The Unfinished Obelisk: The largest known ancient obelisk. It was ordered by Hatshepsut (1508–1458 BC), possibly to complement the Lateran Obelisk (which was originally at Karnak, and was later brought to the Lateran Palace in Rome). The Philae temple is dedicated to the goddess Isis of Love and beauty. The temple complex was dismantled and relocated to nearby Agilkia Island as part of the UNESCO Nubia campaign project, protecting this and other complexes before the 1970 completion of the Aswan High Dam. For those seeking unique things to do in Aswan, this day will offer unforgettable sights and experiences. Overnight on board the cruise. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

### Day 5

## Abu Simbel (Optional Tour) - Departure

Possibility to visit Abu Simbel in the morning as an optional excursion, check out from your Nile cruise, In the morning then we will transfer you anywhere inside Aswan to end your tour. transfer from Aswan to Hurghada about 3 hrs by car, arrive at the hotel, dinner and overnight.
